

Thought and Resistance

This book explains the discourse of resistance in the thought of the Leader of the Revolution and emphasizes the necessity of producing literature and creative content in this field. Its goal is to connect resistance with the values of the Islamic Revolution through a scientific approach that is usable for both general and academic audiences.

Fatimi Heritage

A collection of the Leader of the Revolution's statements about the station and dignity of Imam Mahdi (Hazrat Vali-e Asr, may God hasten his reappearance), compiled by Seyyed Mohammad-Baqer Hosseini. The book, organized into eleven chapters, covers topics ranging from "Humanity's Consensus on Faith in the Savior" and "The Meanings of Awaiting the Reappearance" to "Promoting the Culture of Expectation," "Attention and Intimacy with Imam Mahdi," and "Mid-Sha'ban and the Birth of Imam Mahdi." In its introduction, the Islamic Revolution is presented as a government based on Mahdavi thought that considers itself a prelude to the government of Imam Mahdi.

250-Year-Old Human

This book is based on the Leader of the Revolution's well-known theory that examines the political-struggle life of the Infallible Imams (peace be upon them) not as separate from one another, but as a single unit and one personality spanning 250 years. According to this perspective, the goal and direction of all the Imams have been the same, and their conduct should not be analyzed as contradictory to one another.

The Light of Science

A collection of the Leader of the Revolution's statements from the beginning of his leadership until 1390 (2011–2012) on science, the production of knowledge, research, and investigation. Compiled in collaboration with a group of seminarians and researchers from the Qom Seminary in eight chapters, the book addresses topics such as the relationship between science and Islam and the West, the position of science in Iran, the role of the university and the seminary, and the soft-ware movement (jonbeshe narm-afzari). The book's outlook is

based on the principle that science is not only a necessary condition for the country's dignity and power, but also a driver of economic progress and the improvement of people's lives.

Quran: The Book of Life

A compilation of the Leader of the Revolution's statements on the necessity of the Quran's presence in life and becoming intimate with it. The book discusses topics such as the importance of contemplation (tadabbur), promoting Quranic culture, the etiquette of recitation and memorization of the Quran, and the role of enemies in separating Muslims from the Quran. It concludes with the interpretation of some verses. According to the Leader, the Quran is the healer of problems such as oppression and insecurity, and the salvation of human societies lies in acting upon its practical commandments.

Me and Books

A collection of the Leader of the Revolution's speeches and opinions about books and reading, drawn from his various meetings. The book is organized into six chapters: the importance of reading, his personal memories of studying, criticism of the current situation, solutions, and his notes on books about the Sacred Defense (Iran-Iraq War). In this book, the Leader introduces studying as a religious and national duty. Referring to his memories of reading in his youth, he emphasizes the necessity of daily engagement with books, reading in short intervals, and buying books as one of the main family expenses.

The Truthful Leader

This book consists of the Leader of the Revolution's notes on the cultural-political conduct (sira) of Imam Sadiq (peace be upon him), which were published in 17 issues of the *Jomhuri-e Eslami* newspaper (Khordad 1358 / May-June 1979). Based on the "250-Year-Old Human" theory, the book views Imam Sadiq in continuity with the other Infallible Imams. It explains how, according to the conditions of his time, he chose the best method of struggle (from jihad to cultural work) and details his efforts to establish the ideal government of the Imams.

Khun_Deli_Ke_Lal_Shod

This book is a collection of oral memoirs by Ayatollah Khamenei, detailing his years of imprisonment and exile before the Islamic Revolution. Compiled from his own personal accounts, the book provides specific insights into the conditions of interrogations, life in solitary confinement, forced transfers to various cities, and the coordination of revolutionary activities. The primary purpose of this work is to provide a documented record of this historical era for future generations, while passing on practical lessons in crisis management and perseverance along the path of struggle.

The_Strategy_of-Knowledge-Based_Production:

The Role of Knowledge-Based Companies in the Resistance Economy,” is a collection of statements by the Supreme Leader, compiled by the Vice Presidency for Science and Technology. Across five chapters, the book gathers his meetings with innovators and his visits to technology exhibitions, emphasizing that the path to achieving a resistance economy and economic jihad lies in the development of a knowledge-based economy and production. The primary purpose of this book is to promote a knowledge-based discourse, reduce reliance on the sale of raw materials, and transform scientific knowledge into economic power.

Matla-eEshgh

This book is a collection of advice from the Leader of the Revolution to young couples, based on approximately 300 wedding sermons. Spanning eleven chapters, the book covers topics ranging from the philosophy of marriage to essential skills for shared life. It emphasizes compromise, affection, simple living, and maintaining the privacy of one’s personal life. It includes a famous quote from Imam Khomeini: “Go and build a life together.”

Jihad-eTabyin

This is a collection compiled by Saeid Solh-Mirzaei, focusing on the Leader’s command regarding “Jihad of Clarification.” Across five chapters, the book presents clarification as a collective duty to combat distortion and soft war. It also explores the necessary requirements, tools, and priority topics for effective clarification.

Jihad-e_Moqaddas

This is a collection of the Leader's statements regarding the Sacred Defense, organized into ten chapters. These chapters cover the foundations of jihad, the reasons for the war, and the roles of the people and institutions, as well as lessons and memories. As the representative of the Imam in the Supreme Defense Council during the early hours of the war, his perspectives provide a comprehensive view of the eight years of the Sacred Defense.

Hamasé-ye_Imam_Sajjad

This is an analysis of the political and cultural struggles of Imam Sajjad (AS). The book is divided into three parts: first, the "250-Year-Old Human" theory presented at the Imam Reza Congress; second, four discourses given at the Keramat Mosque in Mashhad; and third, interviews from the Pasdar-e Islam magazine. The book provides a narrative of the Imam's complex management from the period after Ashura until the fall of the Umayyad dynasty.

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
